FROM THE PASTOR DESK ---Pastor Suzanne Jones

Greetings beloved siblings in Christ,

I wanted to take a minute to tell you how much you matter. How much you matter to children, youth, and young families. If you're saying, "Nope, not me - I'm not in children's ministry" - I'm speaking to you most of all. Because you don't realize your impact.

Since January, I have spent most of my Sundays with a group of fantastic teenagers talking about what it means to have faith and what it means to make a decision to follow Jesus. I cannot help but think of all the people at Benevola UMC who have laid the groundwork for this group of confirmation students. In their lifetime, so many people have prayed for them, taught them lessons in Sunday School, included them in activities and showed them what faith and following Jesus looks like.

Every single one of us has influence we are largely unaware of. We think we're not affecting others, yet in reality, our mood, our beliefs, and our values speak loudly - through a glance, an action, or an inaction.

I truly believe if every Jesus-follower truly LOVED our children and youth - even if we have zero programming - it would affect not only our churches but our entire communities. Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." (Matthew 19:14)

Young people are smart. They are intuitive. They know if someone thinks they are a friend. They know if someone sees them as a nuisance. They know if someone disapproves of them.

Can you imagine if every child who walked into church felt surrounded by unconditional love? Like they KNEW going to church meant they would feel LOVED?

I think this is our call. Every one of us. Not just the Sunday School teachers or the youth leaders. But every one of us.... greeters, ushers, worship leaders, pastors, helpers, tech team members, coffee makers, snack bringers, prayer team, bulletin passers, small group leaders, teachers, everyone ... even the ones who sit quietly in the pew or watch online on Sunday morning. Everyone.

So, what can YOU do to help each young person feel surrounded by unconditional love? As a congregation, we will be celebrating our youth in worship as we recognize big milestones in their lives. Come celebrate the youth who will be confirming their faith on Sunday, May 7th. Come celebrate and pray for the graduating class of 2023 on Sunday, May 21. Come celebrate new members who will be joining Benevola UMC on that same Sunday, May 21. God called us to love and that is what we do when we come together and speak into our young people's lives.
